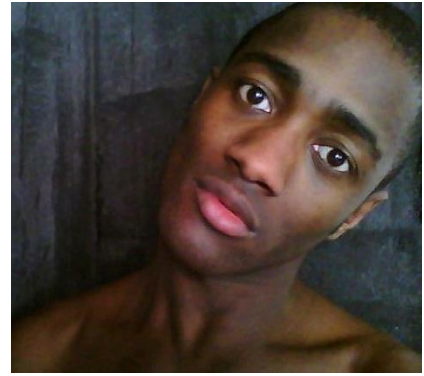


Biography
